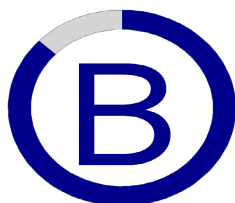

#### Overall Rating



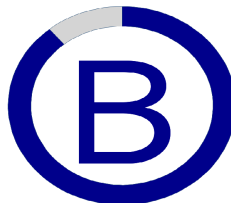

#### Student Achievement



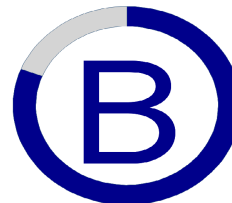
