

This week, students are studying the letter J. They are continuing to study Europe and are celebrating Abraham Lincoln's birthday and Valentine's Day. In honor of Abraham Lincoln's birthday, they will be doing science experiments, art, and sorting activities with pennies. For Valentine's Day, they will do a Valentine's exchange and decorate a sugar cookie for afternoon snack.

1st-5th Grade

This week in reading 1st grade will be working on main idea and details. In social studies they are learning about presidents and patriots. In math they will be working on two dimensional shapes. Science classes are learning about weather. Second grade math students are continuing to learn about time on analog and digital clocks. In reading, students will read and write about Hellen Keller. In 3rd grade reading, students are finishing how-to writing and will have a spelling test on Friday. *Please check for missing library books*. In Math, students are moving on to multiplying by 2-digit numbers and division. Please remember the kids have homework every night that is due Friday. Third grade went on their Safety City trip today and had a great time learning about fire, pedestrian, bicycle, and car safety. In 4th grade reading, students are self-editing, peer editing, and teacher conferencing their persuasive essays as they finish their unit on persuasive writing. In math, students are learning about line of symmetry. In Science, students are studying weather patterns. In Social Studies, they are finishing their study of The Republic of Texas and Anson Jones. DON'T FORGET THAT THE ALAMO PROJECT IS DUE THIS WEEK BY FRIDAY! In 5th grade math, students are continuing their unit on geometry and measurement. In reading, students will finish reading *Out of the Dust*. They will wrap up their study of the sun, moon, and earth in Science and finish studying the Great Depression and World War II in Social Studies.
