

**Edu-Vet, PLLC.,  
Service Agreement  
With  
Roscoe Collegiate Independent School District  
July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2030**

Agreement made this 21st day of April, 2025 at Roscoe, TX, between Roscoe Collegiate Independent School District, a Texas political subdivision located at 1101 W. 7th Street, Roscoe, Texas 79545, and Dr. Scott Snyder, DVM, Edu-Vet, PLLC.

The purpose of this Agreement aligns with RCISDs goal for the P-20 System Model for Student Success:

- To develop a collaborative, sustainable and replicable model for breaking the generational poverty cycle through higher education (EARLY COLLEGE),
- Supplying critical agricultural STEM workforce shortage areas that will be critical to meeting the daunting challenge of feeding and clothing 9 billion people on the planet by 2050 (STEM ACADEMY)
- To ensure that the students of Roscoe Collegiate ISD successfully experience and/or acquire skills through the instruction of Edu-Vet employees.

**The term of the agreement is July 1, 2025 and June 30, 2030.**

Edu-Vet Animal Hospital will remain solely veterinary owned and managed by Edu-Vet PLLC., Dr. Scott Snyder, DVM. For the purposes of this agreement Edu-Vet will refer to Edu-Vet Veterinary Hospital which is owned by Edu-Vet, PLLC, and RCISD will refer to Roscoe Collegiate Independent School District. The Agreement may be reviewed annually with a possible five-year renewal period.

Edu-Vet exists to provide an exceptional clinical environment for the students of RCISD to learn and achieve degrees and certifications. The certifications include CVA level 1, 2 and 3 currently. Progress shall be made to transition from CVA to License Veterinary Technician with an associates degree in applied sciences.

RCISD will continue to own and provide facilities for the education model which includes electricity, water, phone, wifi, computer systems, maintenance and other building systems. Spaces not currently utilized by Edu-Vet will be considered occupied by RCISD.

RCISD will also own and provide all equipment necessary to practice veterinary medicine at the current standard of care in the state of Texas.

A designated RCISD Administrator will be responsible for the STEM Center and will be the liaison between the business and RCISD. Use, repairs, modifications of the facilities will need to be approved by the RCISD Superintendent.

RCISD is governed by the Constitution of the State of Texas and is is governed by a board of trustees who, as a body corporate, shall oversee the management of the district and ensure that the superintendent implements and monitors plans, procedures, programs, and systems to achieve appropriate, clearly defined, and desired results in the major areas of district operations.

Edu-Vet is governed by the Texas Board of Veterinary Medical Examiners and is required to follow Texas Administrative Code Sections 571-577 and the Texas Veterinary Licensing Act.

### **Edu-Vet Animal Hospital**

Edu-Vet Animal Hospital will be owned and operated by Edu-Vet, PLLC., Dr. Scott Snyder, DVM.

Edu-Vet agrees to:

1. Provide a clinical educational environment for students to facilitate certifications and licenses.
2. Provide a clinical educational environment for at least 2 students per semester to have the opportunity to be paid interns.
3. DVM will be onsite for an average of 4 days a week.
4. Operate/support the animal hospital.
5. Develop an agreement with a business to provide reproductive services while at the same time provide educational opportunities for RCISD students.
6. Work closely with RCISD to ensure open communication to provide the best educational opportunity for the RCISD student.
7. Be part of a collaborative relationship with RCISD and the institution that provides a Licensed Veterinary Technician program.
8. Provide semi-annual reports to the Board of Trustees.
9. Edu-Vet, PLLC. will provide monthly invoices for fees.
10. Edu-Vet, PLLC. will also abide by State and District guidelines in regards to fingerprinting and background checks for their employees.

RCISD agree to:

1. Pay Edu-Vet \$195,000 annually divided into 12 equal payments of \$16,250 to be paid by the 1st of each month.
2. Provide and maintain existing Facilities/Service/Equipment as described above.

3. Student transportation will be provided by RCISD.

General and Miscellaneous

If there are any unforeseen circumstances during the life of this Agreement that require substantial changes to the Agreement, either party must do their due diligence and notify the other party in writing within 30 days.

In consideration of Roscoe Collegiate ISD permitting Edu-Vet, PLLC., to come onto RCISD's property to provide certain services, Edu-Vet, PLLC. agrees to hold RCISD and its Board of Trustee, officers, employees, and agents harmless and relieve them from any responsibility or liability for any legal action or damage, cost, or expense (including attorneys' fees) resulting from that work on RCISD property and which may result in any injury to a worker or customer of Edu-Vet, PLLC. that is caused by the action(s) of an employee or customer of Edu-Vet, PLLC..
