Hawley ISD Football Ticket Sales Policy
Updated 8/17/2020

Hawley ISD considers it an honor to host guests and opposing schools to our athletic facilities. We will work to provide you with a safe facility to the best of our ability. UIL guidelines currently require 50% capacity in HISD facilities. In the event that UIL capacity guidelines change, maximum capacity for district facilities will be adjusted. To ensure we are in compliance with UIL guidelines, HISD will be utilizing pre-sales for football to ensure that our parents of our participants have the opportunity to see their children compete.

Tickets for home guests will be available for purchase at the high school office on Monday from 8:00-3:00 for student competitors/participants only (including band and cheerleaders). Competitors and participants DO NOT need a ticket for admission, but this will allow them to purchase the tickets needed for their families to attend. Beginning Tuesday-Thursday from 8:00-4:00 and on Friday from 9:00-12:00, tickets may be purchased by the community at the administration office on a first-come, first served basis. Any remaining home tickets will be available on a first-come, first-serve basis at the gate. All adults and children, regardless of age, will be required to purchase a ticket. There will be **NO REFUND** for advanced ticket purchases, even if a game is cancelled.

Tickets designated for visitor guests will be sold at the gate on a first-come, first served basis. The visiting school may designate the number they need for visiting band members, and that number will be subtracted from their allotted number of tickets. Any tickets (home or away) available 15 minutes before kick-off will be sold to any individual wishing to attend on a first-come, first-served basis. **Tickets sold at the game will only be sold at the main gate entrance by the baseball field.** Pre-purchased tickets and UIL District passes will be accepted at the main gate and the gate by the Middle School Building. The gate by the softball field will not be open for the 2020 football season. Tickets will be required for admission through all 4 quarters. There will no longer be free admission at half-time.

To ensure we are able to accurately count attendance, only official UIL district passes will be honored. HISD will not be honoring senior citizen passes or allowing employees or students to attend free of charge. All HISD students and staff will be required to

purchase a ticket for admission unless they are on duty for the game. HISD staff that are performing job duties at the game will not be required to purchase a ticket.

All stadium visitors must self-screen. Notification of COVID self-screening symptoms will be posted at each entrance. Children 5th grade and under must be accompanied by an adult. All visitors ten years and older must wear a face covering at all times within the stadium unless exempt, per governor's orders. **Children will be expected to sit with their family.**

Away game tickets guidelines are determined by the host school. We will do our best to communicate that information as we receive it. If tickets are sent to the district to sell for away games **for any sport**, the above policy will be used. Priority will be given to participant families.

While waiting for your child's game to begin, please maintain social distancing outside the stadium/gymnasium.
